

Payment and ownership transfer

The next steps to secure your .au domain name



Payment

We will send you a tax invoice by email.

- Payment instructions are detailed in the tax invoice.
- Once payment is confirmed (this can be almost instant or take up to one business day depending on your bank), we move to the next step.



Change of Registrant

We will initiate a 'Change of Registrant' (CoR) process.

- A CoR is required in order to change the legal owner of a .au domain name. This is a simple process that changes the Australian Business Number (ABN) or other eligibility type associated with the domain.
- You will receive an automated email from our parent business (The Lucky Country) with a link for updating the details associated with the domain. We will be notified by email once you have updated the details and will immediately approve the CoR.
- We cover the CoR fees as part of your purchase.



Domain transfer

We will email you an 'authorisation code' that will allow you to start a domain transfer at your registrar of choice.

- Transferring .au domain names is free of charge.
- We receive an automated email once the transfer process has started, allowing us to immediately authorise the transfer to your chosen registrar.
- Transfers are usually completed within a matter of hours, depending on the receiving registrar.
